#### NASA SPACE APPS CHALLENGE



Jyothi Engineering College, Cheruthuruthy, has been selected as a centre for the Nasa International Space Apps Challenge Hackathon to be held on Saturday and Sunday. According to the college authorities, about 3,750 participants have registered for the Hackathon here, and this is the highest number in any single centre across the world. The centre in Cairo in Egypt where about 2,300 participants have registered comes second. As many as 13 space or ganizations from different countries, including Isro, are collaborating to conduct the Hackathon to be held in about 400 plus centres in 165 countries on the same days, Fr. Jose Kannampuzha, the academic director of the college, said. He said the Nasa website has listed 30 challenges that the participants have to face. They can select one challenge and give creative suggestions to address it. A 50 member jury drawn from organizations like Kerala Startup Mission, Kerala State Council for Science,

Technology and Environment (KSCSTE), and Kerala Knowledge Economy Mission (KKEM) has been formed to select the best among the suggestions put forward by the participants, Fr. Jose Kannampuzha said. Three responses selected by the jury from the college will receive global nominations.


