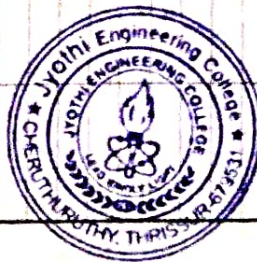

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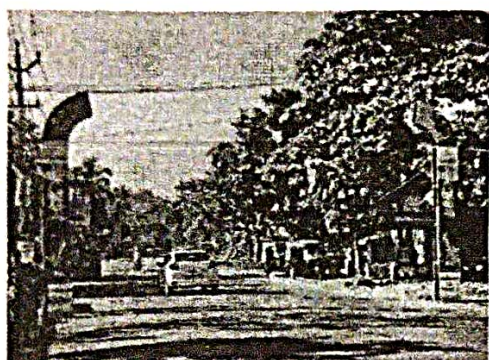

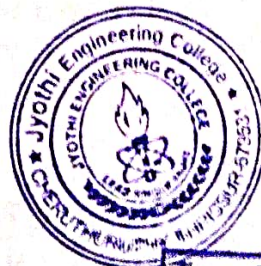

Summary:

In total, we conducted eight boot camps at various locations to raise awareness and facilitate participant registration for the NASA Space Apps Challenge. These boot camps successfully engaged 30 teams in the hackathon, consisting of 27 offline and three online participants. The total expenses incurred during these boot camps amounted to Rs. 2,450 for food and Rs. 3,550 for travel.

During the hackathon, our dedicated team, led by Jyothi faculty, actively interacted with school students and staff who took part in the event. The team comprised Dr. Shiny M.I., Ms. Aswathy Wilson, Mr. Jinesh K J, Mr. Majeendaran, and Mr. Sumesh C. Additionally, we established connections with several schools, including CKM NSS Chalakudy, Bright Line Edappal, Marthoma Thiruvalla.

The hackathon showcased the impressive creativity and skills of the participating students. Notably, two teams designed video games that met college-level standards, while another team ambitiously pursued their idea using Arduino and motors.



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Conclusion:

The collaboration with Unique World Robotics in organizing these boot camps was instrumental in enhancing the skills and knowledge of the hackathon participants. It contributed to the overall success of the hackathon by providing participants with the necessary technical expertise. Furthermore, the connections we established with various schools during this event have opened up new opportunities. By extending our outreach to multiple schools, we have the potential to enhance our college's visibility and increase admissions. Additionally, these connections offer the possibility of organizing a myriad of educational programs and collaborations, fostering a rich environment for learning and exploration.

The hackathon itself served as a breeding ground for diverse solutions. With students designing college-level standard video games and others experimenting with Arduino and motors, we've witnessed the emergence of innovative ideas that hold great promise. This event has laid the foundation for future endeavors that may yield even more groundbreaking solutions and applications in the field of space science and technology.

Recommendations:

Sustain Collaboration: We strongly recommend the continuation of our collaboration with Unique World Robotics in future events. This partnership has proven to be a valuable addition to the preparation process, enhancing the knowledge and skills of our participants.

Prioritize Outreach to Schools and Polytechnics: To maximize our reach and impact, it is essential to focus on schools and polytechnics within our immediate catchment areas before extending to colleges. This approach can help us engage with a broader audience and build strong foundations for future educational programs.

Express Gratitude to Participating Schools: Show appreciation to the schools that actively participated in the event. Building rapport with them can foster long-lasting relationships and provide opportunities for future collaborations.

Enhance Hackathon Management: Strengthen the management of the hackathon by implementing stricter time management and addressing issues related to internet connectivity. A seamless and organized event will contribute to a more productive and enjoyable experience for participants.

Feedback Incorporation: Consider the feedback received from parents and teachers. One of the suggestions is to conduct an event to honor the participants and schools. Vinjana



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Sagar, Thrissur, is recommended as a suitable location for this event. This could create significant exposure if we invite media and YouTube vloggers to cover the occasion.

Engage Experts from ISRO and VSSC: Given the space-related nature of the event, consider involving judges and guest speakers from ISRO (Indian Space Research Organisation) and VSSC (Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre). Their expertise can enhance the event's credibility and provide valuable insights to participants.

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Report of NASA- JYOTHI Hackathon – 2023

Tony C J

Plan:

We arranged parking at the college ground. College ground has the parking capacity of 750 vehicles (4 wheelers). We have installed 10 spot lights at the various points of college ground in order to ensure the proper light in the college ground during night. The two wheelers parking arranged in the way to the GATE NO : 2. We have installed parking sign boards at various points on the way from the GATE NO: 1. We arranged 15 NSS volunteers for the programme during registration time (ie; from morning 07.00 am to 12 pm). After that requirements of the volunteers have been reduced to 5. Volunteers were planned to enter the details of Vehicle owner's name, Phone number and vehicle number (arranged in front of parking area) in a google form in order to keep a record for the future use.

Execution:

During registration 15 volunteers had come for the service. Since the number of vehicles found were very less, we cancelled all the services of volunteers after registration (ie; after 12pm). The number of vehicles are reported at the parking area were around 50. During the night, total vehicle parking was around 20. The parking arrangement went well.



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NASA SPACE APPS CHALLENGE

Jyothi Engineering College, in collaboration with Unique World Robotics, successfully hosted the world's largest hackathon on October 7th and 8th, 2023. The event collected over 3000 registrations from across Kerala, setting a world record for the highest number of registrations. Approximately 1200 participants attended. This 48-hour hackathon provided accommodation and food for the participants.

The event's success was largely due to the dedicated student volunteers from Jyothi Engineering College, Thrissur. Out of 400 students who registered for volunteership, 100 were selected as student volunteers. Among them, 50 took on the role of permanent volunteers, and the remaining 50 served as additional volunteers.

The 50 permanent volunteers were divided into different groups to efficiently manage various tasks like floor management, photography, cultural program and food service. A four member volunteer team were deployed on various floors to provide continuous assistance to participants throughout the 48-hour event. Even during night also, our volunteer team in each floor were readily available to cater to the needs of the participants.

The additional volunteers primarily supported the smooth operation of registration and parking on the first day. Once these tasks were completed, their duties ended.

Permanent volunteers were provided with tea, snacks, lunch, and dinner for two days, as well as official T-shirts. Both teams, permanent and additional volunteers, are eligible to receive volunteer certificates.

A valuable suggestion for improvement is to provide separate bathroom facilities for female volunteers, especially those staying overnight. This change would address the inconvenience they experienced last time when using the limited bath space in student toilets.

4. Attendance Management: Take attendance twice a day for two consecutive days for accurate participant records.



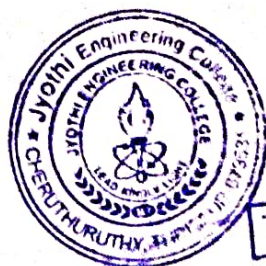

All the toilets were cleaned and buckets and mugs were kept in each toilets. Staffs of CMC were available throughout the hackathon.



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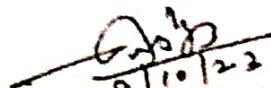

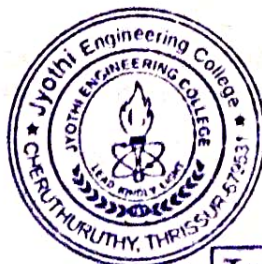

Report on Accommodation Facility at BEd College Mullurkara

Date: 03/10/2023

Introduction:

I visited BEd College Mullurkara to assess the accommodation facility available for school students and for the parents. The purpose of this report is to provide an overview of the facility and explain the reasons why it was not utilized.

Accommodation Facility Overview:

The accommodation facility at BEd College Mullurkara appeared to be well-maintained and equipped to meet the basic needs of students and for the parents. The college classroom were in good condition, and common areas such as halls and washroom spaces were adequately furnished.

Observations:

2. **Private Accommodation:** Some students preferred private accommodation options, such as rented hotels or shared housing, to have more independence and privacy.
3. **Remained in College:** Our college's accommodation facility within the classroom was used by some of the students.

Conclusion:

In conclusion, the accommodation facility at BEd College Mullurkara was well-maintained and met the basic needs of students. However, various factors, such as students being local residents, opting for private accommodation, and in the college, contributed to the non-utilization of the facility by some students.

This report aims to provide insights into the status of the accommodation facility and the factors influencing students' decisions regarding its use.

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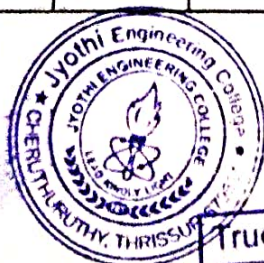

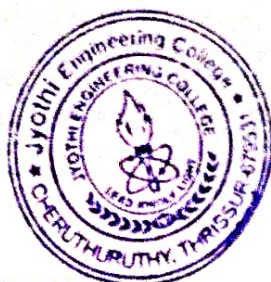
Suggestions
